^Ω**2-day, 3-day, and 5-day (Camp)** rates are for a block of consecutive days. Camp fees are based on a 5-day rate, i.e. Monday to Friday. **Camps** and **Clinics DO NOT** have exclusive use of the Fairground facilities unless negotiated with and agreed to by BADAS (likely with additional fees).

[†]**Public Arena Riding** – available in rings only, when they have not been booked by a user group (check bookings on the “Events/Booking Calendar” under “Facilities & Bookings” on the BADAS web site – www.beaumontagsociety.com). Leave your payment in the drop-box (at Concession building); also leave a completed and SIGNED WAIVER form on your first visit of the year. Please call ahead (780-297-6900) to let the Ag Society know when you will be on-site using the facility. As a payment option, an annual pass can be obtained (cost \$150). Note that volunteer hours can be used to offset costs of using the facilities.

[‡]**Stabling, Outdoor** – 30 open air stalls are available at an extra cost at \$10 per day per stall (1 full-sized horse per stall please). These stalls were NOT built for overnight and extended use, and are therefore rented on a daily basis only. Gate closures for each stall are not provided by BADAS.

[§]**Stabling, Covered** – BADAS opened covered stabling (30-stall pole barn) in 2010. Water for equine use is collected from the roof via a gutter system and collected in large tanks located at either end of the building.

[€]**Garden Plot** – Fee listed above is for BADAS members (see www.beaumontagsociety.com for a membership form) and provides a plot of at least 600 ft² for the growing season (approximately May 1 to October 15). Non-member fees – \$50.
