Cross Country User Policy  
June 8, 2006

1. Authorization **MUST** be obtained from the Beaumont and District Agriculture Society Board before using the Cross Country Course.
2. Bookings are on a first-come-first-served basis.
3. Fees **MUST** be paid and waivers **MUST** be signed prior to riding.
4. In the event of inclement weather and/or poor ground conditions, the facility will be closed. Please confirm availability of the course with the Fairgrounds Supervisor.
5. **Insurance coverage** is mandatory.

All riders must provide proof of current Alberta Equestrian Federation (AEF) insurance coverage. In the event of an out of Province rider, equivalent equestrian Provincial Sport Organization insurance coverage must be proven.

6. **ALL** riders (no exceptions) **MUST** wear approved helmets and riding boots at all times while mounted.
7. **NO** lone riders are allowed.

Each rider **MUST** have a qualified instructor with them at all times. In the instance of the mounted instructor schooling jumps there must be a responsible person, mounted or un-mounted, over the age of 18 accompanying them. It is preferable to have someone carry a cell phone.

8. Closed jumps will be marked as such and cannot be jumped. A penalty will result, including possible lifetime ban from the course.
9. The top rail on Cross Country jumps must remain in place at all times
10. The water jump must be specifically booked.
11. Use of the water jump is prohibited when the water is below the low mark.
12. Report all needed repairs to Fairgrounds Supervisor
